Five technical committees are proposed to deliver the network's objectives within each specific theme. These are:

1. Policy and Standards
2. Buildings and Planning
3. People and Communities
4. Service Innovation
5. Surface Water Management

Terms of reference

The proposed terms of reference the technical committees are as follows:

Each committee will:

1. Consist of registered network members. Registration is free and new members willing to participate in committees are encouraged but will be required to join the network
2. Operate within the terms and conditions of the network as defined here: <http://www.watefnetwork.co.uk/signup>
3. Nominate and cooperate with the chair(s) as he/she who liaises with its committee members and the network's team
4. Operate within the realms of their subject and the annual theme of the network
5. Seek authorisation and operate within agreed budgetary limits
6. Liaise with the network team to deliver its annual outputs in a timely and efficient manner
7. Send representatives to the annual conference to disseminate its outputs

Members can belong to more than one technical committee at the discretion of the committee chair and its members.

Scope of activity

Chairs initialise the scope of activity, clearly defining at least 2-3 deliverables for the first year. This can be policy or practical recommendations.

Meetings

Virtual meetings are encouraged but committee members should physically meet at least twice a year. Meeting minutes will be published on the network website.

Committee outputs

Each Technical Committee will be required to produce:

- Interim Report of findings within 6 months of its' inception
- Full report to be presented at the annual WATEF conference.

Administrative support will be provided to help compile the reports.
